




- Club Excellence helps clubs achieve standards in sport management and sport delivery that establish the foundation for a strong sport system






## Coaching







## **Club Excellence E-Learning**

#### Welcome to the Club Excellence online course!

This tool will help your club identify the areas of operation in which you are doing well, and those where some additional focus is required as you work to build your Level 1 application.

Your first step will be to complete the Gap Analysis Tool, or GAT. When you complete the GAT, your club will be given a score based on how well prepared your club is to meet the Level 1 standards. You will then receive a brief orientation to the course. As you go through each module, you will receive additional information about each standard, templates to help you complete your application and examples of submissions from other clubs. You will follow the story of a fictitious club, the Trembling Mountain Luge Club, and its members who will help you better understand your Level 1 requirements.

Be advised that this course uses your web browser to save your progress. Not all browsers save data the same way; if you leave the course, your progress may be lost.

Volunteers, club staff, coaches... there is a place for everyone, and everyone has a place. Having clearly defined roles and responsibilities is essential to operating any business, profit or non-profit. Those involved ir the dub's operations need to know what their role is with the dub and what responsibilities come with the role. For paid staff, a signed contract demonstrates a confirmation of understanding of the role and its responsibilities, as well as he terms of the employment (e.g., Part time or full time, assonal, permanent, or temporary). For the role Head Coach, a central responsibility is providing regular reports to the board of directors. Regular reporting is essential to bridge the gap between the board and staff when it comes to the iceal's and the realities in program delivery and club operations.
