Engage with Sport for Life experts and peers from anywhere.

Seminars will be based on physical literacy, Sport for Life Long-Term Athlete Development Framework, and community development.

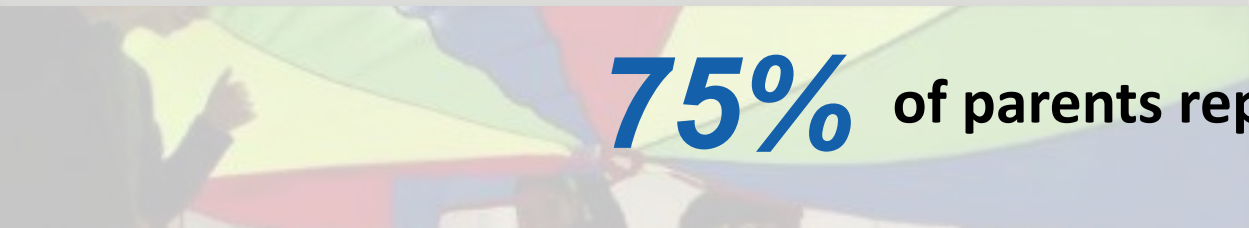

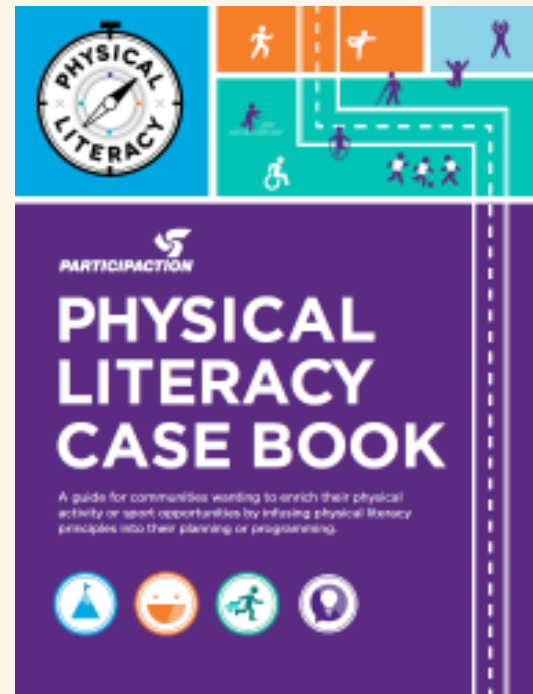

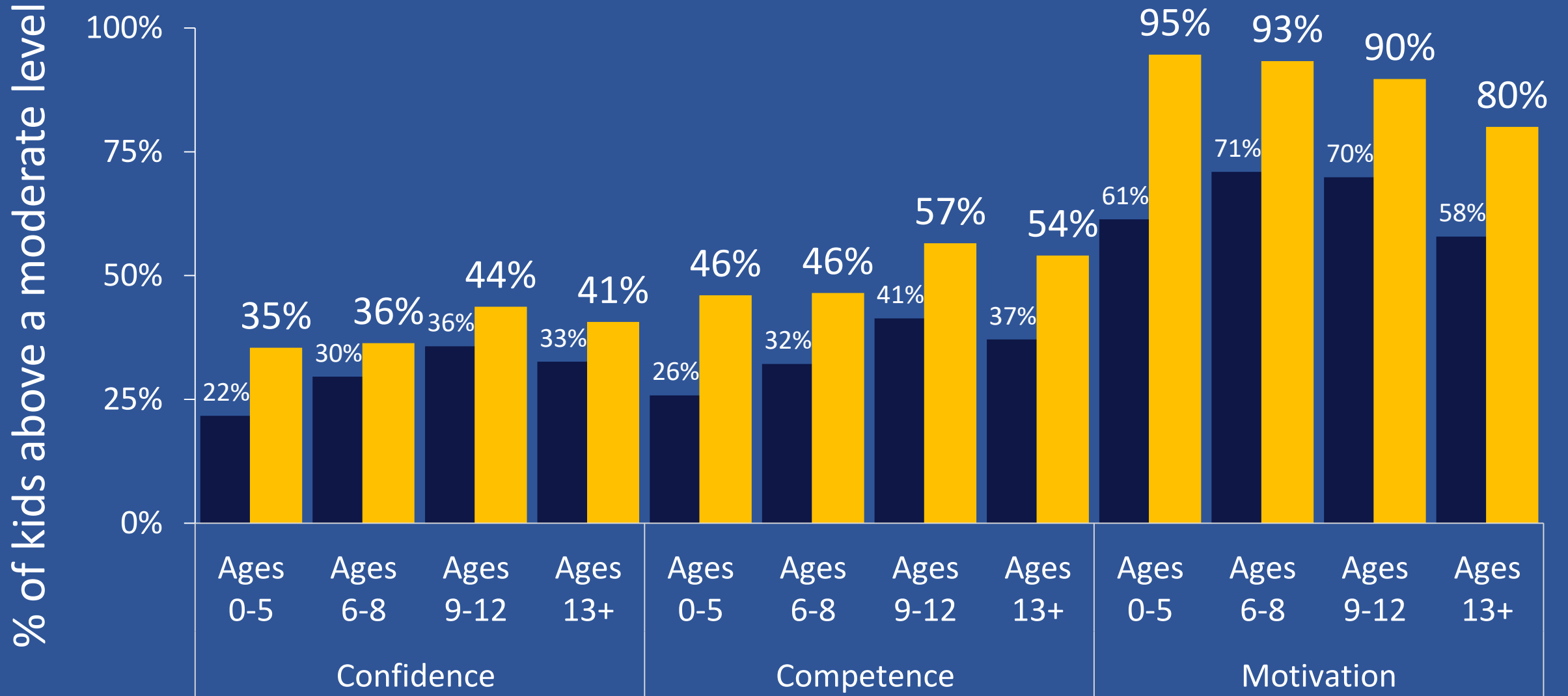

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Program Survey Results 2014-2017



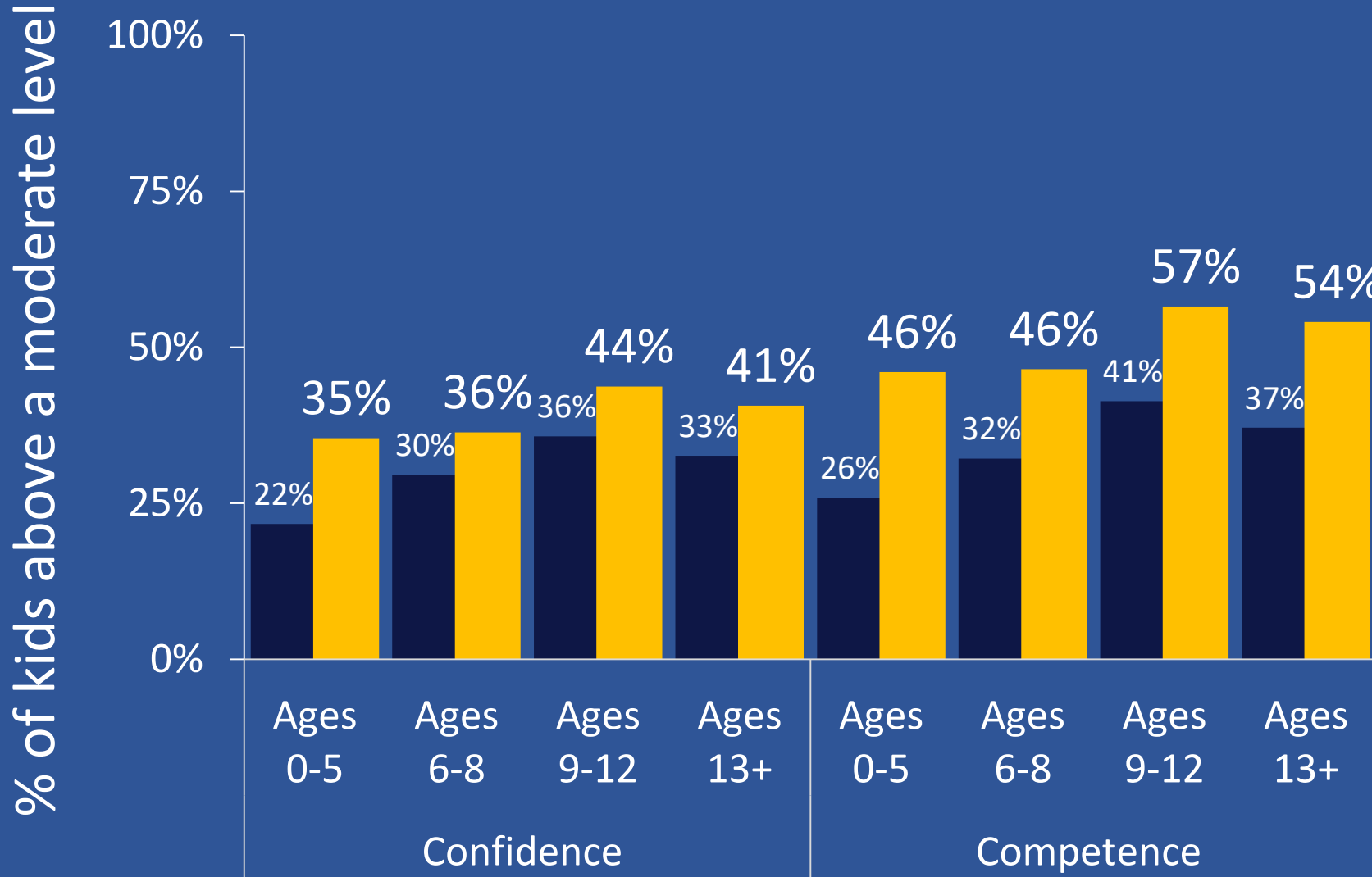
